Choose to begin your 'drive your own car' adventure in Melbourne on Wednesday with an optional welcome dinner. For interstate guests, opt to arrive in the afternoon and enjoy an additional night's accommodation at Crown Towers as well as the welcome dinner. Local guests can also choose to enjoy a staycation in the city, or join us for the welcome dinner only.

In the evening, guests who have opted into the experience will meet for a welcome aperitif and dinner at the hotel's elegant Italian restaurant, Rosetta. Here, you will spend a relaxed evening meeting other tour guests while enjoying award-winning cuisine, and the first of many gourmet dining experiences on this one-of-a-kind tour.

On Thursday morning, the experience will officially begin with a display start and light catered brunch at St Kilda beach. Here, all guests and cars in the group will meet and depart together to start the driving tour. Your first day of driving will take place on open roads, with the route covering a selection of renowned roads throughout the Yarra and Macedon Ranges. In between the twists and turns of the region's meandering and scenic backroads, the group will stop for a gourmet lunch at Levantine Hill, then again for a delightful afternoon tea.

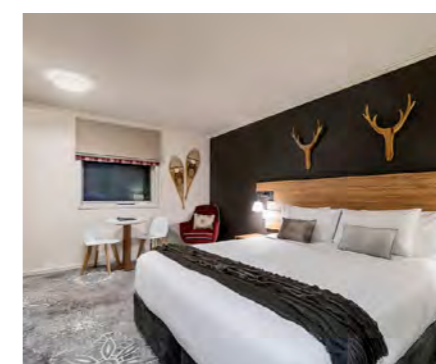
In the early evening, the convoy will arrive into the Lake House and trade car keys for a well-earned glass of bubbly or a cold regional beer. The

hotel lies on the shores of beautiful Lake Daylesford, and is one of Victoria's most celebrated regional venues. After some time to relax and refresh, the group will meet for dinner at the hotel's AGFG-hatted restaurant for Culinary Director Alla Wolf-Tasker's signature tasting menu. Over the course of the evening, Alla and her team will deliver fresh seasonal dishes paired with an acclaimed wine selection.

On Friday morning, the group will depart Daylesford and head east through the north of the Yarra Ranges National Park to link up into the TARGA High Country tarmac rally. The morning will feature a selection of magnificent free-flowing sections of tarmac before we stop for lunch.

In the afternoon, you will wet your whistle for the following days of closed-road rallying with your first couple of stages, including Dry Creek Hill, Mount Terrible and Mount Buller. The first two stages have a bit of everything – fast, flowing sweepers, tight corners and spectacular views over Lake Eildon (if you're brave enough to look down!). The run up Mt Buller is not to be missed, offering the opportunity to watch the competition cars on the final corner of the stage.

That evening, the group will arrive into the Sebel Pinnacle Valley, your home for the next two nights. Enjoy a relaxed dinner before turning in for a good night's sleep.



Accommodation

Each day of this unique driving tour is punctuated by well-earned rest and relaxation at some of the region's finest luxury hotels.

One of these is the prestigious Lake House. Sitting on the shores of Lake Daylesford and surrounded by nature, this gorgeous haven is the perfect evening retreat after a packed day of driving. We also spend two nights at the stunning Sebel Pinnacle Valley – a chic alpine resort at the base of Mount Buller. You also have the option to begin the tour with a night's stay at the sophisticated and lavish Crown Towers in Melbourne, which overlooks the Yarra River.

TARGA HIGH COUNTRY TARMAc RALLY (CLOSED ROADS)



On Saturday, you will enjoy an exhilarating full day of tarmac rallying as part of the TARGA component of the event. Taking part in TARGA will afford you the rare and incredibly coveted opportunity to unleash your favourite car in the most liberating setting – on a closed road. As part of the tour, you will have the opportunity to experience the rally in a non-competitive format, while still taking on the same challenging driving experience as legendary TARGA competitors, including Jim Richards, Peter Brock and even the late, great Sir Sterling Moss.

The second day of the rally is a loop out from Mansfield. The day includes seven closed-road stages, including

Barwite, Tolmie and King Valley. Before lunch, you will enjoy some high-speed flowing stages combined with a twisty run down the valley into Whitfield for lunch at Pizzini Wines. Prepare to do it all over again in reverse after lunch, followed by the famous Mansfield Street Stage and Street Party where you can mingle with the competitors and spectators. After a big day on the roads, we return to the Sebel Pinnacle Valley for a second night of alpine relaxation, enjoying a quiet dinner at the hotel.

Day three of the rally covers the mammoth 49km stage of Jamieson – the second-longest stage on the TARGA calendar – and a reverse of the Friday afternoon run. This stage starts

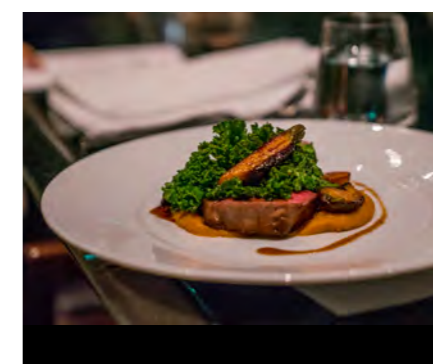
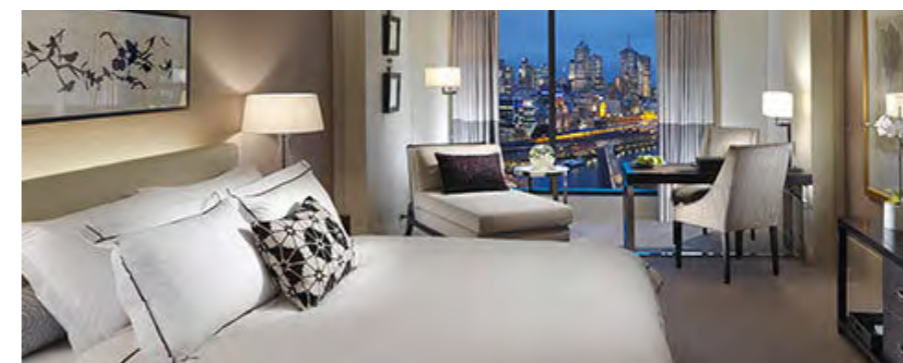
with a twisty, steep uphill run followed by kilometre after kilometre of linking corners that offer no reprieve. It then opens up for a high-speed blast over the top of the mountain before a tight run to the bottom. Regarded by many as one of the most challenging stages in the country, you will feel a sense of relief and elation at the finish line.

In the early afternoon, our tour will peel off from the final stages of TARGA and make our way to Yarra Valley to enjoy a leisurely late lunch at the stunning Yering Station vineyard – a must-see estate that was Victoria's first vineyard. Spend the afternoon relaxing at Yering, taking part in a tasting at their cellar door before sitting down to a beautiful lunch and wine pairing.

As lunch concludes you can choose to drive back to the city, or to take one of our chartered helicopters for a scenic flight from the Yarra Valley back to Crown Towers (in which case, our team will drive your car back for you).

Upon arrival, you will have time to refresh before an optional farewell dinner. Over a final evening of fine-dining, reminisce on the past few incredible days of driving, and making unforgettable memories and new friends.

On Monday, guests can who opted into the final dinner can enjoy a sleep-in and breakfast, after which you are free to depart for onward travel plans.

DAY 1 OPTIONAL MELBOURNE WELCOME

For interstate guests, arrive into Melbourne by late afternoon. Your car, having been transported from your home, will be securely stored and waiting for your arrival.

That evening the group will arrive into the Sebel Pinnacle Valley for a relaxed dinner at the hotel.

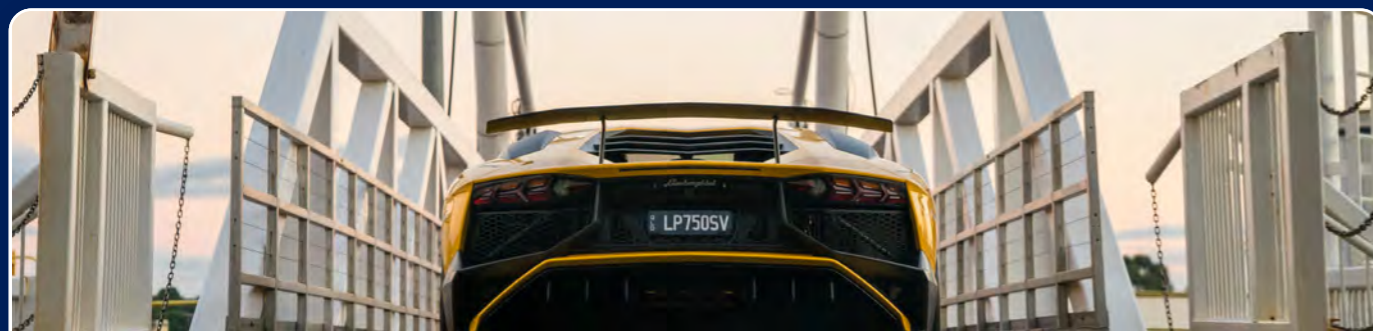

How does the driving work?

The drive operates in a loose convoy, with a lead and sweep car (driven by professional drivers), and two-way radio contact between all vehicles.

The lead car navigates for the convoy and provides updates on conditions, so drivers can focus on enjoying the cars and drive. The sweep car ensures no one becomes lost or separated from the group.

The drive per day is around 250km/155mi over 6-8 hours, including regular stops for morning/afternoon tea, lunch, and driver/car changes.

What type of roads do we drive?

Our team has spent over a decade researching and testing the best roads in the world. All tours are planned so as to avoid heavily trafficked cities and seek out the freedom of the open road. The routes chosen for our tours cover a variety of road types that accentuate both the location and the tour type. You can expect to navigate tight switchbacks and hairpins on alpine passes, and then enjoy loose,

flowing country backroads, and fast-paced autostradas. We always choose roads that are incredibly scenic, so whether you're behind the wheel or in the passenger seat for a section, you will find plenty to enjoy.

What type of guests join your tours?

Guests from around the world attend our tours. We typically host a mixture of groups of friends, families, business associates, and plenty of couples. While we do recommend sharing the experience with someone you know or as a group, we also cater for guests coming on their own. In this case, you will be partnered with another solo driver.

Ultimately, our small-group tours are made up of like-minded people who share a passion for motoring, and enjoying the finer things in life. Many go on to keep in contact after the tour and often become life-long friends.

How does pricing work?

Your tour package is priced per person and is based on two people per vehicle. Typically the driving is shared between

occupants, who alternate between being behind the wheel and being a passenger. In the case that one participant prefers not to drive, the other will be able to enjoy double the time behind the wheel, while the passenger can soak up the stunning scenery and excitement of riding along. As outlined on [page 12-16](#), your Tour Investment consists of your Tour Package and any Optional Add-Ons.

Where do guests stay and dine?

Accommodation and dining are designed to complement your overall experience. Our team seeks out the most luxurious and unique hotels in the regions we visit, which can include ornate castles, private villas, boutique resorts, and more. Dining is always a social affair, pairing gourmet regional or specialist cuisine with fine wine, over which the group can share stories and experiences.
